



# WebTimes ~ Sharing Finish Times

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## Scenario

With Clubs sharing race management resources, this document describes the sharing of finish times from *WebTimes*.

WebTimes uses the Event ID and race-date to link the results data set with the entry list and finish-time stamps.

- Club A runs a combined race for both themselves and Club B.
- Each club has its own entrants list
- Each club needs to produce a result for their own fleet,

Which means Club B needs to get access to Club A's WebTimes data.

## Prerequisites

- Club A requires a WebTimes License Extension
- TopYacht Enhanced Version License Extension.
- Club B needs knowledge of Club A's event ID
- Club B needs knowledge of Club A's Race Date

## On Race Day

Club A run the combined race and capture the fleet-wide finish time-stamps with Webtimes.

This is described in [WebTimes Users Guide](#).

**Note:** In all likelihood, Club B's boats will not appear in the list on the Right Hand side of the WebTimes entry list.

**This does not prevent Club B's finish time stamps from being captured using the same methodology as those for Club A**

Club A can routinely produce and publish results for themselves

## Other Participating Club/s

The other participating Clubs can now access the WebTimes data.

- Log into WebTimes.  
Club B must follow the normal WebTimes startup procedure described in Appendix 2 of [WebTimes Users Guide](#)
