



TopYacht Database Reset.

Synopsis

On rare occasions, an update of the database can be missed with new releases of TopYacht.

This procedure will force TopYacht to update a database to make any field additions to the database tables as needed.

If TopYacht encounters a missing field during execution, it will crash.

Routinely the last line of the crash report will read something like 'ABCDEF GH_IJK-L not found', where 'ABCDEF GH_IJK-L' in the field name in one of the tables of the TopYacht database

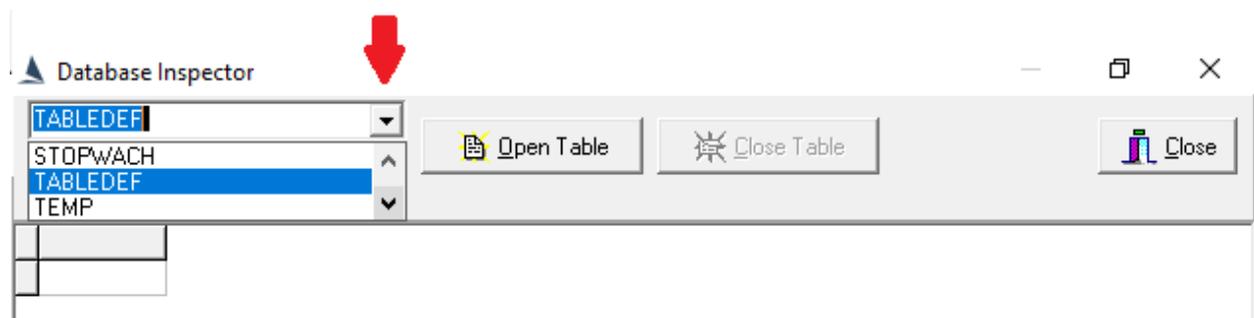

Click on the dropdown box, scroll to TABLEDEF.

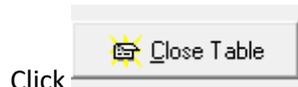

The restarting of TopYacht will force the database definitions **for the currently-selected database only** to be updated to the latest revision.
