

# TES ~ How to Enter a Keel-Boat Sailing Event.

### This guide is for keelboat racing NOT for Off the Beach racing.

TES allow you to enter sailing events at many clubs and regattas.


Once you have entered one event, the boat details (AND uploaded "boat docs") and your details are available to make it very quick and easy to enter other events.

### To Start an Entry

Click on the Entry Link provide by the host Yacht Club. Routinely, it should be included in the Notice of Race, or on the event web-page.

Failing this, click on <a href="https://www.topyacht.com.au/db/kb2/events">https://www.topyacht.com.au/db/kb2/events</a> display.php. The event you are seeking should be towards the top of the list. Click on the event...

The link will send you to a page similar to this.



There are three options:

View Entrants

Enter Series / Multi Series Entry

Race Entry / Casual Entry

- Click *View Entrants* to view a list of boats that have entered to date.
- Click Enter Series / Multi Series Entry to enter a single race as a series entry. It opens a new page where you can select the Series you wish to enter.

The Organising Authority elects whether the Multi Select option is available to prospective entrants.


- Click *Race Entry / Casual Entry* to enter a single race as a casual entry.
  - o Casual entrants will not receive a series score for Club racing.
  - Casual entries are not permitted in a regatta. Entrants must enter for the whole regatta. The
    organising authority may choose to offer discounts for a limited number of races sailed, but the boat
    will be allocated a DNC score for all races not sailed.

Before you can commence your entry you need to confirm whether your boat is stored in the TopYacht Boat Registry; and you are nominated as the owner.

# Enter Series /Update Entry / Add Crew STEP 1: Select Series To enter just one Series - select that Series below. This provides an entry page for just that Series. To enter a number of Series, use the `Multi Select` option. This provides an entry page where you can tick off each of the Series you wish to enter. Firstly, verify the boat is already in TopYacht, and you are registered owner.

Click the link TopYacht Boat Register.

- If your boat exists then proceed to the section: <a href="Entering a boat ALREADY in TopYacht">Entering a boat ALREADY in TopYacht</a>
- If the boat has changed owners then contact TopYacht via the link towards the bottom of the entry page.

Click Here to change Owner/Main Contact or Email Address for existing boat.

If you boat is definitely not there, then proceed to the section: Entering a boat NOT already in TopYacht Boat Register.

## **Entering a boat ALREADY in TopYacht**

#### **STEP 1: Select Series**

#### Either click the

- 1. A Single Series. (Entering Additional series subsequently uses this same screen), or
- 2. Multi Select option (to enter a number of Series at the one time),

### **Option 1:** A Single Series.

Select a single Series that you wish to enter, for example click on the radio button for Spring Saturday Series.



### Option 2: A Multi Series

### STEP 2: Select an Entry Option




### STEP 3: Press Submit

to progress to the Login Page.

### Logging in

Enter the boat's sail number and the password of the main contact for that boat. The main point of contact is normally the owner of the boat.



### If the Log In Fails?

- > Try again.
- If it still fails, use the "Forgotten Password/PIN" utility. Your password will be emailed to the email address stored in the TES database. Check the junk and spam folders if the email does not appear in your email In Box.


# **Entering a boat NOT already in TopYacht**

### STEP 1: Select Series

Select the Series as per the preceding section.

### STEP 2: Select an Option

Select the last Entry Option ie Enter boat NOT in TopYacht Boat Register



STEP 3: Press Submit

# **Completing the Entry Form – Intro.**

### **Important Notes**

- For a boat already in the TopYacht boat register, most of the fields will be pre-populated with previously stored information e.g. boat name, sail number, your name etc. This makes the whole process very fast.
- For a boat NOT already in TopYacht, then you must populate all the fields on the form for the first Series that you enter.
- Some fields are marked with an asterisk (\*). These fields MUST be complete or you will not be able to submit your entry



- > The data collected is Club Dependant
- The following is an example of an entry form for a NEW boat i.e. there are no pre-populated fields.

# **Entry Form - Boat / Handicap Details**

This example collects only basic information about the boat. The Organising Authority dictates the information to be provided about the boat.



In the above example, you MUST complete each box/field except the Maritime Regist'n No.

The next section differs considerably from one event to another. A basic layout example is shown below. There is nothing you need to fill in, in this case.

# **Entry Form - Primary Contact Person Details**



The "Primary Contact Person" is the person nominated as the Single Person Accountable (SPA) to receive any correspondence about the boat, has the address for the insurance renewal etc. Normally this is the owner.

This MUST be a real person as explained in the next section; NOT 'J Small / 'as the first name, and 'K Brown' as the last name for joint owners.

If you do not have an email address, insert the words "no email address".

### **Entry Form - Joint Owners**

Event organisers/clubs require a single, *real* person as a "Single Person Accountable" for a boat, so organisers have a single address to mail club information etc.; chase insurance information etc.

The reason is similar to banks, which require a Primary Card Holder for a plastic card.

Joint owners are handled by inputting the details in the Name to display as SKIPPER".

Name to display as `SKIPPER`. This can be `James Cook OR `J Cook / B Hughes` Leave this blank UNLESS the name is differen	
First Name:	Last Name:

For example the first name can be input as "J Smith" and last name becomes "/L Brown".

You do this as part of the entry.

Just above this part of the form, there is provision for a "Secondary Email" address and an "Additional SMS" mobile so two person's contact details can be recorded to receive any electronic messages from the club.

Further, making your "Single Person Accountable" a 'joint person', will cause issues when entering each person separately for the crew list for overnight/offshore racing.

# **Entry Form - Selecting Fee Option and Payment Option**

The fee options will vary dramatically between one club/event and the next.

Below are some examples.

Most clubs use the TopYacht Entry System to collect their entry fees.

If your club does not, then **ignore this section**.


In this case a boat can only tick the Prepaid option IF they have already entered and paid for (in this case) the **Season Entry**. The other fee options are self-explanatory as are the payment options.


## **Entry Form - Check it out before Submitting.**

Before submitting the entry, check the page and verify all mandatory fields are complete (the one with the asterisk)

In the case of a NEW boat, it is not able to upload "boat docs", you will still need to check the box as shown below OR the Submit will fail.



Once you believe that the form is complete, read the Conditions of Entry then tick the **Conditions of Entry** box at the bottom of the screen and press the Submit button.



# **Entry Form - Oops- I have errors!**

You have pressed the Submit button but instead of submitting the page it takes you to the top of the page with a list of Errors in red.

Fear not! The errors tell you want needs fixing.

Please fix the error(s) or omissions listed below then submit your entry.

2 - Please tick the *Required Documentation option

In this example the boat Design is missing and the Required Documentation is not ticked.


Once these are fixed then pressing the Submit again will result in the entry being accepted.

# **Entry Form - The Entry Confirmation Page**

When your entry is accepted you will be passed to the Entry Confirmation page.

This summarises your entry.

For events that are collecting fees, there will be an additional area detailing the fees and the payment method chosen. If payment is by Credit Card, then a link to a secure payment gate-way will be available.



Once you have checked these details, Click Here at the bottom of the page to return to the entry starting page.

#### **Important:**

If you entered a NEW boat, then do an Update Entry as per the next section so you can upload documents as required.

# **Entry Form - Updating an Entry**

On the entry starting page click on the Enter Series / Multi Series Entry option

View Entrants

Enter Series / Multi Series Entry

Race Entry / Casual Entry

On the Enter Series page select the Series in Step 1 as per previously then select the **Update** existing entry details in selected Series in Step 2.



This will take you to the entry page populated with the data previously provided.




## Entry Form - Selecting Several Series at Once- "Multi Select"

The procedure for selecting multiple Series at the one time is the same as entering a single series with the following changes.


**STEP 1**: Select the First Option



STEP 2: Check EACH of Series box you wish to enter. There are no fees in this example.




The following example has a fee for each Series Selected. The entrant will pay the total of the fees for the Selected Series. The fee structure demonstrates a Club's non-member / member policy.



## **Appendix 1: Searching the TopYacht Boat Register**


Click on this link.

http://www.topyacht.com.au/mt/boat list.php. It lists some 12,000 boats!!.



To search for your boat either enter the boat name or sail number or your name in the search box in the top right.

For example to search for boats that have "OATS" in the boat name; we get the following.



If you can find your boat then you know it already exists in TopYacht. If it is not to be found, then you need to create new entry and put in the boat details as part of the new entry.

Clicking for a boat loads a photo of the boat provided this has been previously uploaded by the owner.
